COURSE CRITERIA and STRUCTURE

Orientation Course (Preparatory Phase)

- 1. The Orientation Course runs parallel to the previous Level I Course.
- 2. Attendance at the Orientation Course is desired, but not compulsory and will depend on the playing/coaching experience and cricket knowledge of the candidate.
- 3. The only requirement for the Orientation Course is that candidates must be at least **16 years** of age to attend.
- 4. The Orientation Course will last for a minimum of **SIX hours** normally to consist of **THREE** modules of **TWO** hours each. The structure will be determined by the relevant Coaching Manager/Course Administrator.
- 5. There is no examination or formal evaluation. However, candidates who go on to register for the Level I must be aware that they will have to write a preliminary test based on the content of the Orientation Course (see point 2 below).
- 6. Candidates who are present for the duration of the Orientation Course (all 6 hours) will receive a certificate of attendance from the relevant provincial office.

Level I Course (Basic Skills – Teaching Cricket to Junior Cricketers)

- 1. The minimum age requirement for candidates who wish to register for this particular course, is **18 years.**
- 2. All candidates must write a preliminary test to prove their general cricket knowledge and in order to continue with the Level I course, candidates must attain an **80% pass mark.** This test is based on the content of the Orientation Course.
- 3. The duration of the <u>Level I Course</u> is 18 hours but the actual sequence of the modules will be determined by the relevant Provincial Coaching Manager/Course Administrator and must include ALL the prescribed course content. The course evaluation consists of a 1-hour written exam as well as a practical coaching assessment.
- 4. Successful candidates will be entitled to a certificate within a month of successfully completing the course exam and evaluation, but certification will be subject to the submission of the results to the CSA Coaching Education Department by the Affiliate Member.

Level II Course (Intermediate Skills - Coaching Schoolboy and Junior Club Cricketers)

Requirements for registration:

- 1. Candidates must be **21 years of age or older** to register for the Level II Course.
- 2. A candidate must have **EITHER**:
 - a) Held a Revised Level I certificate for at least 12 months;

b) Be in possession of a pre-2005 Level II coaching certificate;

OR

- c) Played a minimum of 10 representative games at <u>first-class</u> level.
- **3.** The <u>Level II Course</u> consists of EIGHT 3-hour Modules (24 hours), plus a 1½-hour written paper as well as a 1-hour practical assessment.

Once again, the actual sequence of the modules will be determined by the relevant Provincial Coaching Manager/Course Administrator, but must include ALL the prescribed course content.

4. Successful candidates will qualify for a certificate after successfully completing the course and overall evaluation and logging the required 40-hours practical coaching.

NB!! The Affiliate Members must without exception, adhere strictly to the suggested course structure and above-mentioned criteria and refer to the general course guidelines as contained in the official Coaches Academy information pamphlet.
