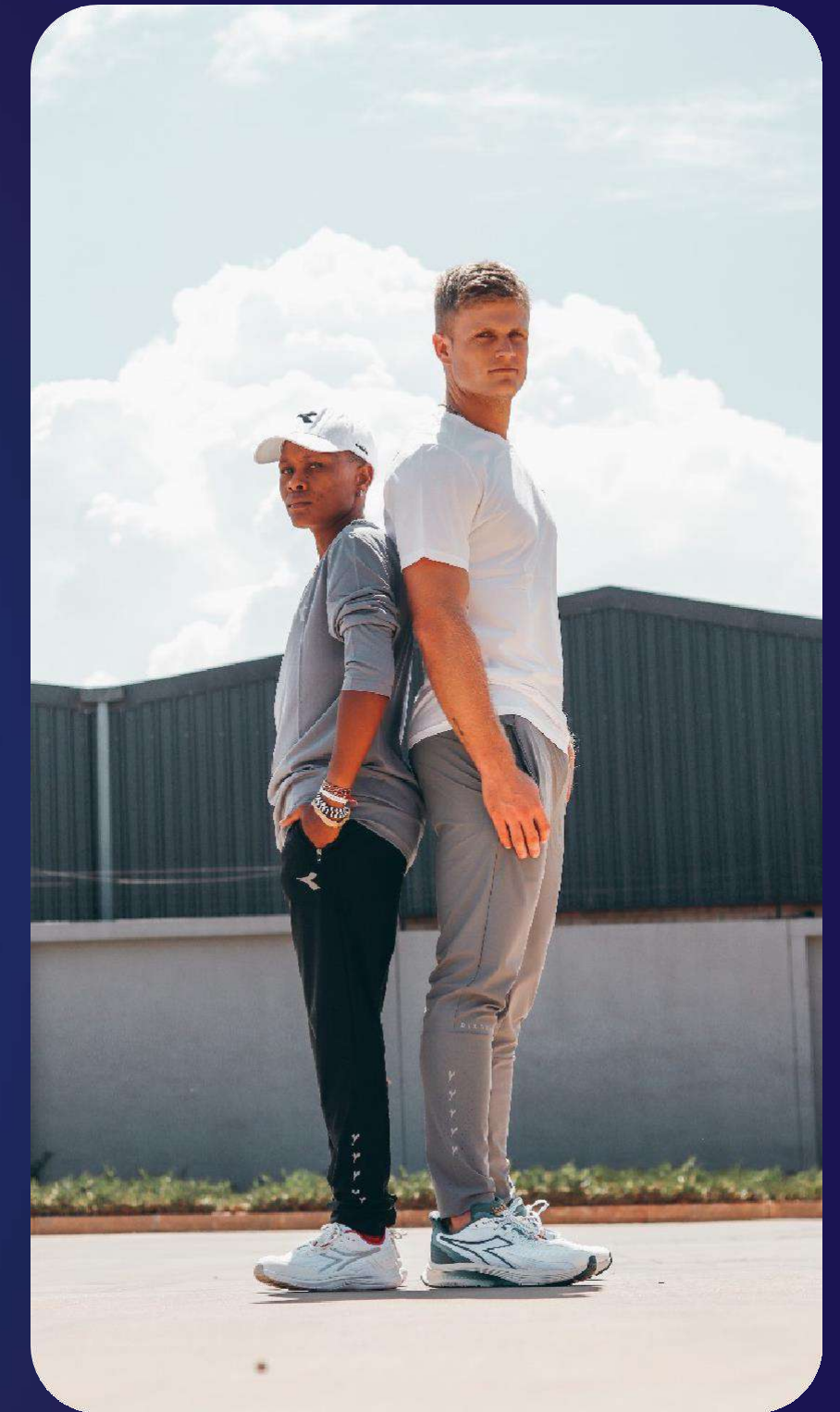

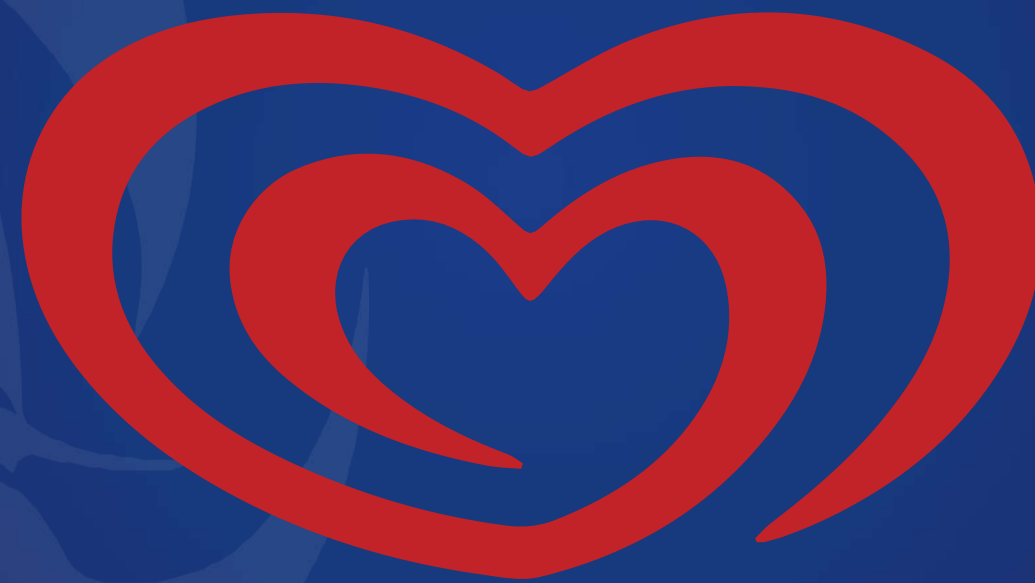

PLAYING CONDITIONS 2024

Subject to the provisions of these conditions, the Central Gauteng Lions 20 Over Competitions playing conditions: 2023/2024 shall apply.

1. GENERAL RULES:

- 1.1. The teams may consist of players that are a
 - 1.1.1. maximum age for age group teams (e.g., turning 11 or younger in the year of the competition to play in the Under 11 Age Group), or a
 - 1.1.2. minimum age of 40 for the Veterans league (i.e., turning at least 40 in the year of the competition).
 - 1.1.3. No age restrictions are imposed in all the other open leagues.
- 1.2. Only official Diadora Jozi Cup clothing is to be worn.
 - 1.2.1. Where awarded, Player of the Match caps may be worn during a player's next match.
- 1.3. Match officials – umpires and scorers to be provided by CGL for each match.
- 1.4. All finals will take place at the DP World Wanderers Stadium.

1.6. The Pitch length will be the standard 22 yards (20.12 meters) for all matches except for the Under 11 Age group where the Pitch length will be 19 yards 12 inches (17.68 meters).

1.7. Ground, Square and Pitch conditions.

1.7.1. Once a ground is handed over to the umpires by facility ground staff it will remain under the umpire's authority until all matches for the day on that field are concluded or accounted for.

1.7.2. Once a venue is handed over for then day to the umpires, no match at the venue will be abandoned due to wet conditions without the consent of the Match Referee responsible for that venue.

1.8 Fitness of the ground during Diadora Jozi Cup:

1.8.1 The Diadora Jozi Cup is an innovative and exciting approach to the game, the conditions of fitness of any ground are therefore amended herewith to play as much cricket as possible.

1.8.2 The inspection of the ground, square and pitch areas will be done by the umpires and Match Referee as frequently as possible and reasonable, unaccompanied by any players or other officials (Law 2.8.3).

1.8.2.1 Umpires are to pay special attention to the bowlers' run-up area and pitch area where the bowlers land and follow through.

1.8.3 In the event of the conditions of the field and/or square and/or pitch not being fit for play (Law 2.7.1 to 2.7.4) the umpires must consider if bowling all the overs of the match from one specific end will address the concerns and allow play. The Match Referee for that venue will make the final decision in this regard after consultation with the match umpires and a thorough inspection of the venue. Such a decision will still be based on the principles of dangerous and unreasonable play (Law 2.7 and 2.8).

Example:

It would be unreasonable for a bowler to not have an option of bowling over or around the wicket.

1.8.4 If 1.8.3 is safely doable the match will commence as soon as possible. Time lost will be noted and overs allocated to the match will be adjusted accordingly.

1.8.4.1 Once a decision is made in this regard the whole of the match will be played in this manner regardless of any improvement in the condition of the field, square or pitch area.

1.8.4.2 If a match is played in such a manner the following needs to be borne in mind:

- Umpires are to change ends after every over.
- Batters are to change ends after every over.

1.8.5 If play in this manner still includes the playing field, square and pitch area being dangerous or highly unreasonable, play will not commence. In these instances, the conditions must continuously be monitored by the umpires and the ground staff must continue working on the affected areas.

1.8.6 For each subsequent match(es) at the venue concerned the Match Referee, together with the umpires, will assess the field/square/pitch conditions and decide based on an updated assessment.

2. THE PLAYERS

2.1. Only registered players are allowed to play in the Diadora Jozi Cup.

2.1.1. Player registration is defined by the "Original Squad" names submitted to the tournament co-ordinator prior to the official start date of a respective division.

2.1.1.1. The official start date refers to the whole division, not a respective team's official start to the tournament.

2.2. Any specific team's squad size is limited to the 16 players as provided by a club per 2.1.1.

2.2.1. Should a specific team only register a 14 player squad prior to the official start of the tournament, two additional players to make up numbers 15 & 16 may be added. These can be players not registered at the official start date of the tournament granted the player/s do not contravene Rule 1.1 or Rule 2.5 – 2.7.

2.2.1.1. Allocation of these players must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director no later than the Friday before the match by 13h00.

2.2.1.1.1. Permission will be granted unless players in question contravene Rule 1.1, Rule 2.5 and/or Rule 2.6.

2.2.1.2. In addition, and in light of a club's pipeline, two (2) players may be added to the above 16 player squad; provided they are already registered for the current year's tournament and have played in their originally registered team per the submitted squads sent.

2.2.1.3. Registration of these players must follow 2.2.1.1.

Example:

A team has 14 registered players; player numbers 15 & 16 can include those not previously registered for Diadora Jozi Cup, but player numbers 17 & 18 must be registered players for the current Diadora Jozi Cup season.

2.2.2. Any player outside of the "Original Squad" submitted to the Diadora Jozi Cup Office must play a minimum of 4 round robin matches for the team he/she has been promoted to in order to be eligible to play in any knock-out stages. This refers to all knock-out stages, i.e., quarter-final, semi-final and final matches.

2.2.2.1. If more than one team of a club makes it to the knock-out stages, a player may not represent their club in more than one match during the knock-out stages regardless of their eligibility to do so in multiple divisions.

2.2.2.1.1. Should such a situation arise, the club is to decide on which division the player will participate in and inform the Diadora Jozi Cup office of their decision.

2.2.2.1.1.1. The player will play all knock-out matches for that chosen division.

2.2.2.1.2. Should a player's team be knocked out of a division, the player may not move up or down a division to play in another knock-out stage for their club.

2.3. A maximum of 14 players per side can participate in a match but only 11 are allowed to bat or bowl respectively.

2.4. Registered players are not allowed to play for more than one club regardless of whether they are playing in different divisions.

2.5. Registered players are allowed to play in a different division for the same club, provided they are not playing in an age group where they would be over age.

2.6. Three (3) outside players may play for a club per team (i.e., players from unions outside of CGL).

2.6.1. Players from within CGL, playing for a club different to their summer season club, will not be considered as external players.

2.6.2. Special dispensation to be granted by the Tournament Director to invitational teams should this be received in writing at the point of team entry.

3. THE TOSS

- 3.1. The toss is to be completed by the reserve umpire or CGL representative at least 20 minutes before the start of the fixture. The reserve umpire/CGL representative can call the teams earlier for the toss pending the situation of the other games being played.
- 3.2. Teams are to provide a team list with correct player names and player shirt numbers to the standing/reserve umpire/CGL representative at the toss.
- 3.3. Punitive measures for teams arriving late:
 - 3.3.1. If a team does not have at least nine (9) players present at the match venue at the latest time for the toss to be taken, they will forfeit the toss.
 - 3.3.2. If a team arrives late and the start of the match is delayed due to them arriving late, their batting innings will be reduced. This will be done by calculating the number of overs lost in accordance with the actual match time that was lost.

Example:

Fifteen (15) minutes are lost:

$15 \text{ minutes} \div 3.75 \text{ minutes per over} = 4 \text{ overs lost to the defaulting team in their batting innings.}$

- 3.3.2.1. In these instances, the number of overs allocated to each bowler of the non-defaulting team remains unchanged. Each bowler is still allowed a maximum of four (4) overs.
- 3.3.2.2. The powerplay overs will be adjusted according to the relevant table in the CGL Playing conditions.
- 3.3.2.3. If a team's innings is reduced due to late arrival, the run rate will be calculated on the allotted overs for a full innings (20 overs).
- 3.3.2.4. If both teams arrive late, both teams will be penalised by the number of overs they are late for their respective innings.
- 3.3.2.5. If the defaulting team loses more than fifteen (15) overs (56,25 minutes), they will forfeit the match as they will not have sufficient time available for their batting innings to bat the minimum number of five (5) overs.
 - 3.3.2.5.1. The non defaulting team will be awarded 6 points (4 points for a win + 2 bonus points).
 - 3.3.2.5.2. The defaulting team will be penalised by 4 points.

4. PLAYING TIMES

- 4.1. Matches will start promptly at the times listed below for both Sunday and Night venue fixtures.
- 4.2. Please note 20 overs must be bowled with a maximum of 75 minutes per innings of a match (refer to point 4.6 for penalty runs to be awarded).
- 4.3. Timetable of matches where a maximum of 3 matches can be played at one given venue on a Sunday:

- 4.3.1. Should only one or two matches be fixtured at a venue; the first match will still commence at 08:30 am.
- 4.3.2. Games 2 and 3 for a Sunday fixture can start as soon as the previous match has been completed granted this is within 30 minutes of the next start time.
 - 4.3.2.1.1. This may only be done if both teams, umpires and scorers are ready to commence.
 - 4.3.2.1.2. If all parties are not ready, normal start times apply.

4.4. Timetable of matches where a maximum of two matches can be played at any given night venue:

4.4.1. Games 2 of the night venue fixtures can start as soon as the previous match has been completed granted this is within 30 minutes of the next start time.

4.4.1.1. This may only be done if both teams, umpires and scorers are ready to commence.

4.4.1.2. If all parties are not ready, normal start times apply.

4.5. The fielding side shall be in position to bowl the first ball of the final over of the innings before the scheduled (75 minutes) or re-scheduled end of the innings time. This time will be calculated by the umpires and will take delays or interruptions during the match into account.

4.6. Should the scheduled or rescheduled close of play be reached and there are further overs remaining in the innings, the over in progress will be completed and the innings shall be closed.

4.6.1. Penalty runs shall be awarded to the batting side as follows, the greater of:

- 10 runs per over for each full incomplete over remaining, OR
- The actual run rate achieved at that point of the innings per over for each full incomplete over remaining (whole rounded down numbers apply, no decimals).

Example 1:

At 09h46, there are 2 overs remaining. The batting team has achieved a run rate of 9.2 runs per over. 10 runs shall be awarded for each uncompleted over.

Therefore 2 overs x 10 runs / over = 20 runs shall be added to the score of the batting team.

Example 2:

At 09h46 there are 3 overs remaining. The batting team have achieved a run rate of 11.35 runs per over.

Therefore 3 overs x 11 runs / over = 33 runs shall be added to the score of the batting team.

4.7. Losing or retrieving a ball is no reason to interrupt the game. Umpires must be handed used spare balls at the beginning of the match. If a ball is lost it should be replaced immediately with used balls.

4.7.1. Spare balls are to be provided by CGL. Umpires must satisfy themselves that the used ball is in a reasonable condition to continue play.

4.8. Time wasting:

4.8.1. The incoming batter must cross over with the outgoing batter on the field of play. The incoming batter must either be ready to face the next delivery or ready to let the other batter face the next delivery within 90 seconds of the wicket falling, failing which, the batter will be dismissed (on appeal) as Timed Out.

4.8.2. The umpires must monitor time closely and inform the fielding captain often (at least every 4 overs) on their over rate.

5. THE OVER

- 5.1. An over will constitute only SIX (6) deliveries (including no balls and wides) per over.
 - 5.1.1. Unless the last delivery of any over is called a "No Ball", the Free Hit must be taken in the same over and be bowled by the same bowler.
 - 5.1.1.1. The Free Hit, as the last delivery, must be taken until a legitimate ball is bowled (note rule 5.1.2).
 - 5.1.2. If the last delivery of any over, outside of the PowerPlus overs or final over of the match, is called a "Wide", the ball will NOT be re-bowled.
 - 5.1.2.1. This will apply even if this Wide delivery is bowled after a Free Hit.
- 5.2. In the PowerPlus overs and the final over of the innings, SIX (6) legitimate deliveries must be bowled in each of these overs.
 - 5.2.1. Should close of play for the innings be reached before the allotted overs have been bowled, the umpires will inform the fielding captain and batters at the wicket that the current over will be enforced as the final over of the innings.
 - 5.2.2. Only for the u11 division:
 - 5.2.2.1. A maximum of 8 balls will constitute an over regardless of how many wide or no balls are bowled.

Example 1:

During the PowerPlus overs or the last over of the match, bowler bowls five legal deliveries followed by one "Wide" delivery, as called by the umpire. Ball 7 is also called a "Wide"; if ball 8 is deemed to be a "Wide" delivery too, the over will be considered complete.

Example 2:

Should ball 7 of Example 1 be called a "No Ball" and ball 8 is called a "Wide", Rule 5.1.2 applies.

Example 3:

Should ball 8 of Example 1 be called a "No Ball", the over will be considered complete.

- 5.3. Each bowler will be allowed to bowl a maximum of 4 overs.
- 5.4. A minimum of five (5) overs of spin bowling is required in each innings of twenty (20) overs.
- 5.4.1. Spin bowlers will be identified to the umpires by the fielding captain. (Refer to 5.4.4).
- 5.4.2. In a reduced match the spin requirement will be reduced proportionately, as per the table below:

Length of Innings (Overs)	Spin Overs required
5	1
6 – 9	2
10 – 13	3
14 – 17	4
18 – 20	5

- 5.4.3. Umpires are to monitor and inform the batting side of how many overs of spin have been bowled.
- 5.4.4. SIX points will be deducted if a team fails to comply with the minimum spin requirements.
- 5.5. Field Restrictions:
 - 5.5.1. During the Fielding Restriction Overs (first 6 overs) a maximum of two fielders shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area (inner circle) at the instant of delivery as per normal CGL 20 Over Competitions playing conditions.
 - 5.5.2. During the non-Fielding Restriction Overs, no more than 5 fielders shall be permitted outside the fielding restriction (inner circle) area.
 - 5.5.2.1.1. Should a team for some reason have less than eleven (11) players on the field while fielding they will still be permitted to have a maximum of five (5) fielders outside the fielding restriction area at the instance of delivery.

Example:

The fielding team only has ten (10) players on the field of play. After subtracting the bowler and wicket keeper they only have eight (8) fielders. As they are allowed to have a maximum of (five) 5 fielders outside the fielding restriction (inner circle) area, they will thus have the balance of three (3) fielders that must field inside the fielding restriction area.

6. WIDES AND NO BALLS

6.1. Runs conceded for Wides and No Balls during any over of the match will be calculated in the following way:

Wide/No Ball	RUNS	HOW TO GET TO TOTAL	TOTAL
1 st Extra in the over	1 Runs	EXTRA + 1 Penalty Run	2 Runs
2 nd Extra in the over	3 Runs	EXTRA + 3 Penalty	4 Runs
3 rd Extra in the over	5 Runs	EXTRA + 5 Penalty Runs	6 Runs
4 th Extra in the over	7 Runs	EXTRA + 7 Penalty Runs	8 Runs
5 th Extra in the over	9 Runs	EXTRA + 9 Penalty Runs	10 Runs
6 th or more Extra in the over	11 Runs	EXTRA + 11 Penalty Runs	12 Runs

**Please note that for the purpose of this table, an "EXTRA" only refers to a WIDE or NO BALL.*

6.2. The penalty for Wides and No balls will apply to all overs in a match.

6.3. The penalty runs awarded per these Playing Conditions will not be penalized against the bowler but will count towards the batting team's total.

6.4. All runs scored in this manner will be in addition to all other runs completed by the batters.

6.5. The strict leg side wide interpretation is in place.

6.5.1. However, for the u11 division umpires are to apply a more lenient (normal time cricket) approach to the wide interpretation.

7. POWERPLUS OVERS

Each team will have two (2) overs, namely PowerPlus Overs (PP), where the following will apply:

7.1. Calling of PowerPlus overs:

7.1.1. The on-strike batter is responsible for calling the PowerPlus overs.

7.1.2. The request must be made to the bowler's end umpire.

7.1.2.1. In an U11 match, a coach may call the PowerPlus.

7.2. The bowling team has the option to change to a preferred bowler upon the call of the PowerPlus overs.

7.3. Once the request has been made by the batting team, the request may not be revoked.

7.4. Umpires will signal PowerPlus overs by blowing a whistle and wearing a coloured bib.

7.4.1. The bib will be worn for the duration of the PowerPlus overs.

7.5. PowerPlus overs must be taken consecutively.

7.5.1. These 2 overs can be taken anytime between overs 1 to 16. However, if not taken, the PowerPlus overs will automatically apply in overs 17 and 18 (unless Rule 7.7 has been applied).

7.6. In any shortened innings the PowerPlus overs cannot be taken in the last two overs.

7.7. In the interest of fairness, should a team bat first and were not able to take their PowerPlus overs in an innings that is reduced due to any unavoidable reason, the opposition will not be able to call the PowerPlus overs in their batting innings.

7.7.1. However, should the batting team call their PowerPlus overs and are bowled out or their innings come to an end for any other reason before the completion of the PowerPlus overs, the opposition may take their full PowerPlus overs in their innings in the prescribed manner.

7.8. Normal fielding restrictions as per the playing conditions will apply during the PowerPlus overs (i.e., if the PowerPlus over is taken during overs 1-6, a maximum of 2 fielders are allowed outside of the inner circle, and if taken during overs 7-16 a maximum of 5 fielders will be allowed outside the inner circle).

7.9. If the bowling team is penalized for slow over rate and the PowerPlus overs were not taken the batting team will be awarded double the penalty runs for the PowerPlus overs not taken.

Example 1:

At 09h46, there are 4 overs remaining a none of the PowerPlus overs have been taken.

The batting team has achieved a run rate of 9.2 runs per over.

Penalty runs to be calculated as follows:

2 x PowerPlus overs = 10 runs x 2 x 2 Overs =	40 runs
2 overs = 10 runs x 2 Overs =	20 runs
Total runs awarded to the batting team =	60 runs

Example 2:

At 09h46 there are 3 overs remaining and only 1 of the PowerPlus overs has been taken.

The batting team have achieved a run rate of 12.94 runs per over.

1 x PowerPlus over = 12 runs x 2 x 1 Overs =	24 runs
2 x overs = 12 runs x 2 x 2 Overs =	48 runs
Total runs awarded to the batting team =	72 runs

7.10. Scoring during this period

7.10.1. Runs scored OFF THE BAT will be doubled.

7.10.1.1. Runs scored in the PowerPlus period will go to the batter, however, the doubling of the runs will be recorded as team runs (penalty runs).

Example:

The batter hits a boundary four during the PowerPlus overs.

4 runs are credited to the batter and debited to the bowler.

4 runs are credited to Penalty runs for the batting side and against the bowling side.

Total runs scored and conceded = 8 runs

7.10.2. Extras will not be doubled during the PowerPlus overs, however, competition rules for Wides and No balls (see Rule 6) will apply.

7.10.3. Loss of a wicket is minus 10 runs to the batting side.

8. POINTS

8.1. Points will be awarded for the following:

- 4 points for a win
- 3 points for a tie/no result due to rain
- Forfeiture:
 - o The non defaulting team will be awarded 6 points (4 points for a win + 2 bonus points).
 - o The defaulting team will be penalised by 4 points.
- 0 points for a loss
- 1 bonus point for a team scoring 100 runs in their innings.
- An additional 1 bonus point for a team scoring 200 or more during their innings.

8.2. Additional bonus points that can be awarded:

8.2.1. Batting bonus points

- 1 point for losing by less than 10 runs.
- Should a team batting second achieve the winning total in 80% of the overs they will be awarded 1 bonus point.
- OR should a team batting second achieve the winning total in 50% of the available overs they will be awarded 2 bonus points.

8.2.2. Bowling bonus points:

- 1 bonus point for a team achieving 8 wickets.
- OR 2 bonus points for a team bowling out the opposition.
- Should a team bowling second restrict the opposition to 80% or less of the required score, 1 bonus point will be awarded.

8.3. In the event of rain or an unexpected stoppage (bad light) during a match, the Run Rate per over will be calculated and used by the standing umpires to calculate any revised target scores. No extra time will be allocated.

8.4. If a match is rained out a draw will be recorded between the two teams.

8.5. In the event of a tie in the round robin stage, the game will be recorded as a draw. However, in the quarter-final, semi-final and final, a tie will be decided by a super over to declare the winner of the match.

8.5.1. The super over will constitute 6 legitimate balls.

8.5.2. Rule 6 (Wides and No Balls) will still apply.

8.6. If teams finish on equal points following the round robin stage, promotion to the semi-finals or finals will be determined in the following order of priority:

- The result(s) of the fixture(s) involving the two sides in the round robin stage.
- The team with the most match points
- The team with the most bonus points
- The number of wins
- The number of losses
- Net run rate

8.7. Play-off matches and Finals:

8.7.1. If there is one group in a division, the top 4 teams will play the semi-finals, where the team finishing 1st plays 4th, 2nd plays 3rd.

8.7.2. If there are 2 groups in a division, the top two (2) teams will play in a semi-final where the winner of the one group plays 2nd in the other group.

8.7.3. If there are 3 groups per division a quarter-final will be scheduled whereby the top 2 teams per group will advance and teams 7 & 8 will be those who finish at the best third position (based on total points and thereafter Rule 8.6 above).

8.7.4. Four groups per division: a quarter-final will be scheduled whereby the top 2 teams per group will advance to a quarter final and the winners will progress to the semi-finals.

9. OTHER RULES

9.1. Teams are to be present at the venue at least forty-five (45) minutes before the toss.

9.2. If there are any age/DOB queries, they should be raised with umpires/CGL representatives at the field who will then refer this to the Tournament Director.

9.2.1. The coach/team manager should have copies of birth certificates/ID documents collated printed or digitally for easy reference should a query arise.

9.2.2. If a team plays an over-age player 6 (six) points (4 points for a win + 2 bonus points) will be deducted and 4 (four) points will be awarded to the opposition who will also have the fixture recorded as a win.

9.3. In the Veterans League Only:

9.3.1. The squad size of any veteran's team is limited to 20 players.

9.3.2. The use of runners while batting will be acceptable if a player is injured on the day.

9.3.2.1. In the event of an opening batter needing a runner from the start of the innings, the runner must be somebody who will bat lower than number 7 in the order. Once a batter, apart from the injured striker, is dismissed or retires the dismissed or retired batter must become a runner immediately.

9.3.3. Rule 9.2.2 applies in the instance of a veterans team playing a player who has not turned the age of 40 in the year of the competition.

9.4. There will be 10 penalty runs incurred for any unacceptable behaviour by parents and/or coaches including abuse directed towards match officials and CGL representatives. Negative parental involvement will not be tolerated in any form.

9.4.1. Should any person choose to interfere in the tournament, the third umpire/CGL representative (LOC)/match referee reserve the right to instruct the person concerned to leave the premises immediately.

9.5. Please refer to the CGL Code of Conduct and the Diadora Jozi Cup DC Express Addendum.

10. HAVE FUN

1. The final playing condition is to enjoy every match and play it in the spirit of cricket, our 'Lions Way'.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

ANTI CORRUPTION POLICY

Under no circumstances may any person at the ground use a mobile telephone, computer or other kind of communication device either,

- to communicate or in any way transmit any form of commentary, data or other material in relation to a cricket match taking place at the ground for any kind of improper betting or other corrupt or unlawful purpose; or
- to conduct betting activity in a public pitch-facing part of the ground in a way which, in the event organisers or its appointed nominee's opinion, otherwise brings the game or Central Gauteng Lions into disrepute or which offends (or is likely to offend) other spectators.

Patrons participating in these activities will be requested to leave the venue.

CRICKET EQUIPMENT

- **Colour** - There are no colour restrictions.

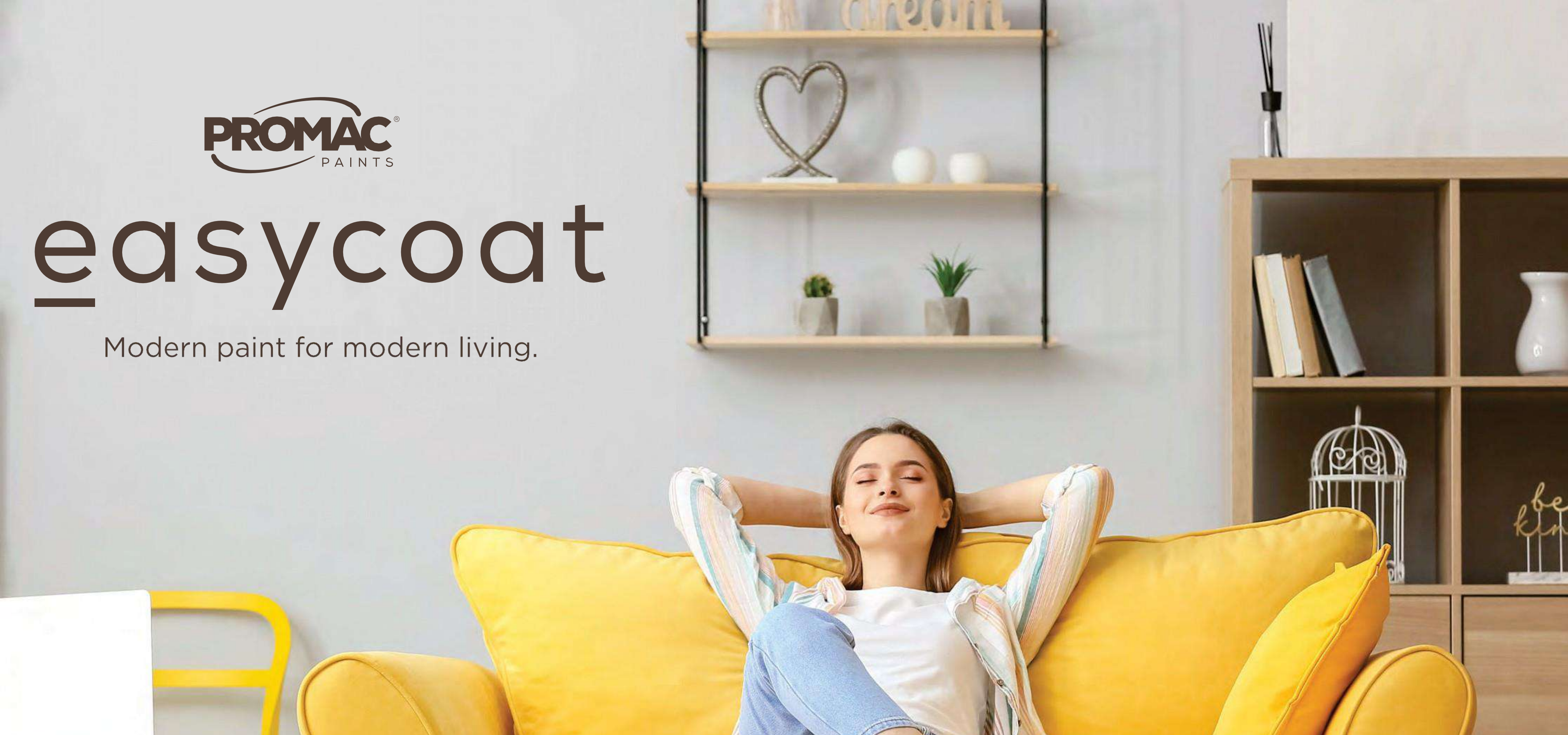
Bats (Player Right)

- **Colour** - Apart from the inclusion of any commercial logo, manufacturer's identification and/or player initials each in accordance with the Regulations below there shall be nothing on the remainder of the front, back or sides of any bat which alters or otherwise affects the natural colour of the wood to any significant extent. Any player wishing to use a bat which may contravene this Regulation should consult with and seek BCCI's prior written approval, such approval to be given at BCCI's sole discretion.
- **Commercial Logo** - One Player's Bat Logo is permitted on the back of the bat. The area of the Logo must not exceed 64.5sqcm (10 square inches) with all sides of the Logo being at least 2.54cm (1inch) long.
- **Player Initials** - Two sets of player's initials are permitted on the bat. One set is permitted anywhere on the back of the bat and the other is permitted anywhere within the top 10 inches of the face of the bat. Such initials shall not be more than 2cm (0.78 inches) in height.

The role of the match referee is to assist the appointed match officials in ensuring that games can commence and are the final voice in their cancellation.

Once commenced they will assist in adjudicating on any controversial issues that may arise.

They are not there to overturn any umpiring decisions but will advise on unclear points of law / Playing Conditions.

Maintaining and managing discipline in any cricket game is important. Not only does it enhance the traditions and values of the game, but it also results in the game being played in a fair manner.

With the number of matches taking place during Diadora Jozi Cup and the fast pace of the format, there is little time to move through the standard CGL Disciplinary process.

With the above in mind, the CGL Disciplinary Carding system that is in place for CGL Premier league cricket will be utilised for the duration of the Diadora Jozi Cup. This will ensure real-time action is taken. The Diadora Jozi Cup Disciplinary System will only be utilised for Premier Ladies, Premier Blue, Premier Yellow, Senior Men's Open and Veterans leagues.

It must be noted that the Diadora Jozi Cup Disciplinary Carding System is for on-field Code of Conduct breaches only. Off-field incidents are to be reported to the existing CGL Disciplinary Committee in terms of the CGL Code of Conduct.

The Diadora Jozi Cup Disciplinary System serves as an addendum to the CGL Code of Conduct.

The Diadora Jozi Cup Disciplinary System will comprise of three (3) cards; green, yellow and red. The below dictates how and when each card will be issued.

1. GREEN CARD

A green card is issued as a caution to the following:

- 1.1 General swearing/unacceptable language only audible on-field.
- 1.2 Showing dissent towards an umpire's decision by word or action.
- 1.3 Disregarding an umpire's match related instruction or request.
- 1.4 Engaging in verbal contact with an opponent that could bring game into disrepute but may not be clearly audible to at least one of the umpires.

The issuing of a green card is intended to serve as a preventative measure to diffuse any potentially volatile, or situations of conflict, from escalating.

Once a green card is shown for any of the above transgressions, it will serve as a caution to that particular player as well as to the rest of that team for the remainder of that innings.

2. YELLOW CARD

A yellow card will be issued for the following:

- 2.1 Receiving a second green card for the same type of offense (even though it may not be the same player if the first green card has been issued as a team caution).
- 2.2 Showing serious dissent at an umpire's decision.
- 2.3 Loud swearing/unacceptable language audible by spectators off the field of play.
- 2.4 Swearing/ unacceptable language directly at a fellow participant or umpire.
- 2.5 Giving an extreme "send-off" to a batsman upon dismissal either by gesture, verbal comment or both.
- 2.6 Making obscene gestures directed at a fellow participant or an umpire.
- 2.7 Making of verbally abusive comments of a personal nature to or about a fellow participant or umpire.
- 2.8 Abuse of cricket or ground equipment (on the field incidents only).
- 2.9 Inappropriate and deliberate physical contact between players in the course of play.
- 2.10 Charging or advancing towards the umpire in an aggressive manner.
- 2.11 Throwing the ball at or near a participant (defined in CGL Code of Conduct) in an inappropriate and/or dangerous manner.

Sanction for receiving a yellow card when batting:

- a. If a batsman of the team batting first receives a yellow card after having been dismissed, that player will not be allowed to field for the first two (2) overs at the start of the innings of the team batting second.
- b. If a batsman of the team batting second is out and has already fielded (for clarification: his/her match is over and has no further role to play in the match) 10 penalty runs to be awarded the opposing/fielding team.
- c. If the batsman is **not out** (still batting), the player is sent off immediately and the next available batsmen must replace the suspended player. The suspended batsman can only return to the field of play at the fall of a wicket/another batsman retiring or being suspended (to be carried over into fielding innings if applicable). If a batsman cannot complete his/her innings due to such suspension, his/her innings to be recorded as "Retired Out".

Sanction for receiving a yellow card when fielding:

- a. The fielder is sent off for the remainder of the over and two overs thereafter. The suspended fielder can only return at the start of the third over following suspension (to be carried over into batting innings if applicable).
- i. If fielding second and less than two overs remain in the innings, five (5) penalty runs will be awarded the opposing side per over remaining in that innings or part thereof.
- b. No substitute fielder is allowed for the suspended player during the period of suspension.
- c. The returning player can bowl immediately after the over in progress has been completed.
- d. If the wicketkeeper is suspended a substitute wicketkeeper will be allowed. However, in this instance the fielding Captain must nominate another fielder to leave the field of play for the period of suspension (this particular fielder's period of absence from the field of play will not be regarded as a suspension to him/her but to the wicketkeeper).

The issuing of a yellow card needs to be reported to the CGL Disciplinary Committee for purposes of record keeping, and possible disciplinary action. This is to be noted on the match card and included in the umpires after match report.

3. RED CARD

A red card will be issued for the following:

- 3.1 Deliberate serious/severe physical contact with an opponent or umpire.
- 3.2 Any threat of assault or physical harm to an opponent or umpire, either by word or action.
- 3.3 Using language or a gesture that offends, insults, humiliates, intimidates, threatens, disparages, or vilifies another person on the basis of that person's race, religion, gender, colour, descent, national or ethnic origin.
- 3.4 Any team member that receives a 2nd yellow card in the same match.
- 3.5 Upon any member of the same team receiving a 2nd yellow card in the same match where team received 2nd yellow card.

Sanction for receiving a red card when batting:

- a. If a batsman of the team batting first receives a red card after being dismissed, the player is sent off for the rest of the match and will not be allowed to field – no penalty runs awarded to opposition.
- b. If a batsman of the team batting second is dismissed and has already fielded (for clarification: his/her match is completed and has no further role to play in the match) 10 penalty runs to be awarded the opposing team.
- c. If a batsman of the team batting first receives a red card while his innings is in progress, the player is sent off for the rest of the match and will not be allowed to field – no penalty runs awarded. The innings of such a batsman will be recorded as "Retired Out".
- d. If a batsman of the team batting second receives a red card while his innings is still in progress, the player is suspended for the rest of the match. 10 Penalty runs to be awarded to the opposing team. The innings of such a batsman will be recorded as "Retired Out".
- e. The umpire needs to report the matter whereafter a formal disciplinary process will follow.

Sanction for receiving a red card when fielding:

- a. Player is sent off (suspended) for the rest of the match.
- b. The umpire needs to report the matter where after a formal disciplinary process will follow.

Process following receiving a red card:

Any red card sanction is to be reported to the Tournament Director immediately by the match referee/third umpire/Lions LOC representative. The CGL Disciplinary committee will be informed and any further sanctioning will occur in real-time. The sanction is still to be noted on the match card and in the umpires after match report.

- a. The red card sanction applies to the game currently being played. The CGL Disciplinary Committee, through the Tournament Director, will inform the sanctioned player if the sanction (not allowed to play) is to be followed through to the player's next match.
- b. Should the sanction apply to a following match, this affects the sanctioned player and not the team.
- c. A player can appeal the sanction but this needs to be done in real-time and according to the CGL Code of Conduct. The CGL Disciplinary Committee will decide in real-time based on the findings.

4. GENERAL

- 4.1 If the player refuses to leave the field after receiving a yellow or red card, the Laws of Cricket (2017 Code 3rd Edition-2022) insofar as a team refusing to play will apply. (Law 16.3: Awarding of the match to the opposing team)
- 4.2 If the same player receives a 2nd yellow card within a tournament, a disciplinary hearing will be held, resulting in possible suspension of the player as per the applicable Code of Conduct.
- 4.3 If a batsman is sent off the field and there are no new batsman remaining to come in, the innings is completed.
- 4.4 In any event of a yellow or red card being issued to a player the matter must be reported to the Disciplinary Committee who may decide to hold a formal disciplinary hearing, if they as Disciplinary Committee are of the opinion that a more serious sanction should be imposed following a guilty verdict.
- 4.5 Any referral in this document referring to him/his includes players, participants (as defined in the CGL Code of Conduct) and officials of all sexes.
- 4.6 When a player receives a red card, he/she may not be replaced by another player from the nominated 14 players for the remainder of the affected match. In this instance the team will only field or bat with ten (10) players.
- 4.6.1 If the CGL Disciplinary Committee sanctions the player for any matches thereafter it does not affect the team.

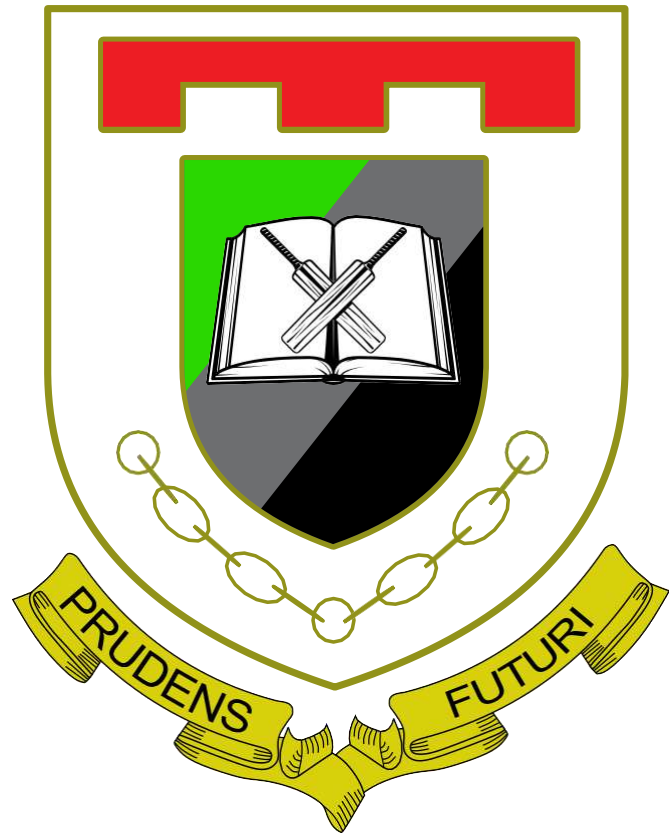

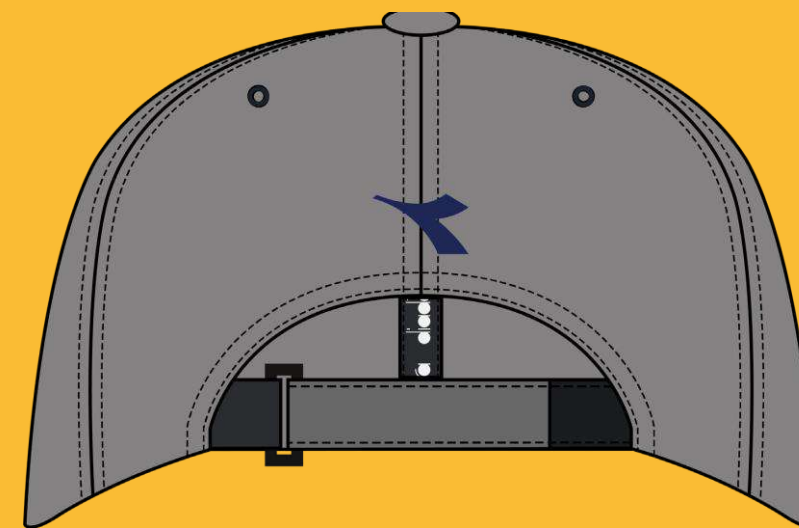

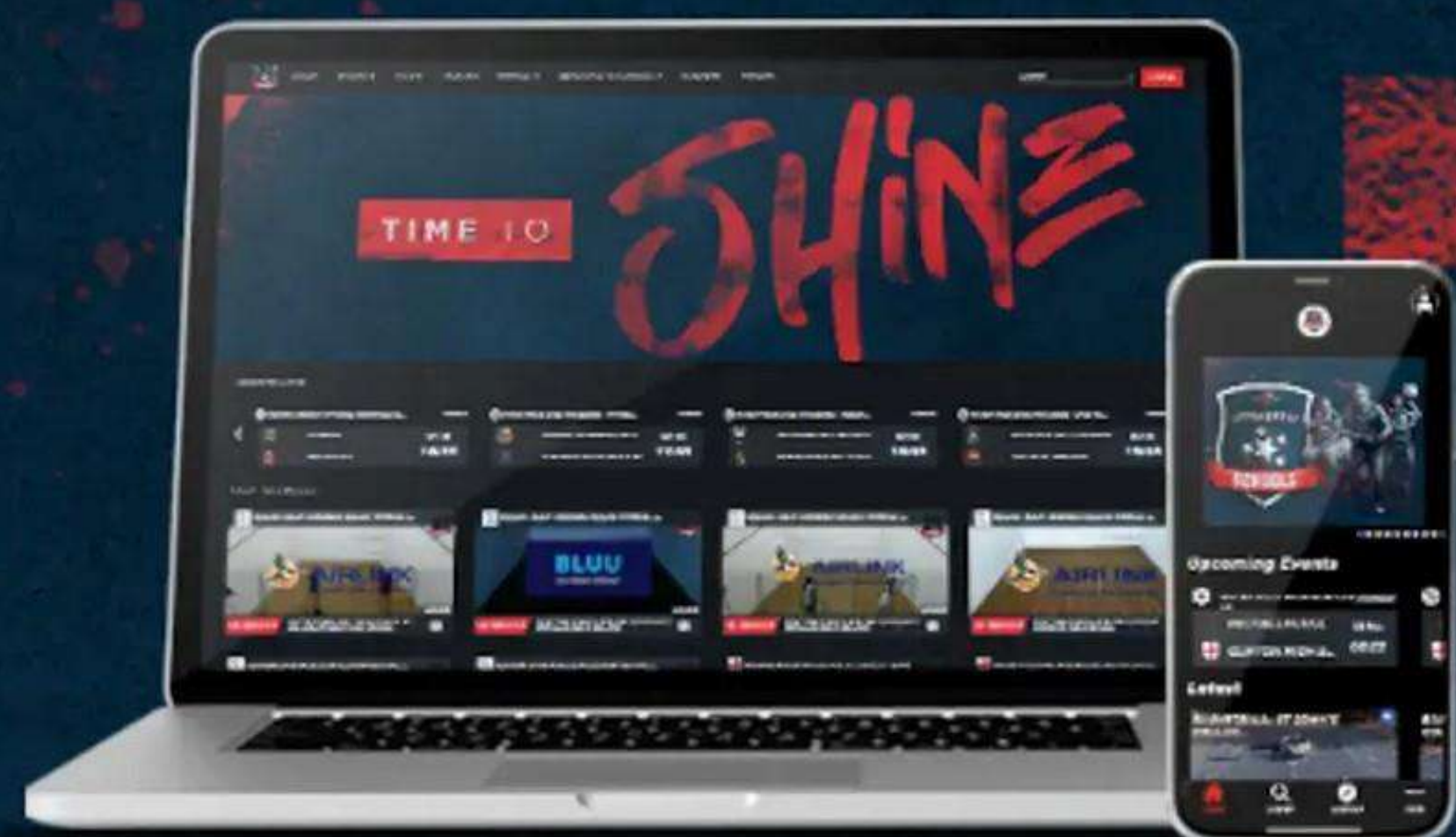

Fixturing can only truly begin when all clubs have finalised their team entries and no further changes are accepted. Fixturing and subsequent availability of facilities is impacted by the following:

- Club and school facilities converting to winter sports which means fewer available wickets.
- Availability changes of Diadora Jozi Cup venues/facilities in the lead up to the First Ball post registration of clubs.
- Clubs entering team/s without availing facilities proportional to the team entry.
- Fewer Premier facilities available – linked to sporting code changes and Diadora Jozi Cup entries.
- Converting a summer season's worth of fixtures into a 7 week, Sunday only tournament.
- Match official capacity restrictions.

Division of teams into various groups per division:

- All teams in any division are to play an equal number of games in the Diadora Jozi Cup.
- Division into groups is based on:
 - o Alphabetical order of teams
 - o The number of teams entered in a division by a specific club (i.e. limiting teams from the same club playing in the same group).
- Teams are to play a minimum of seven (7) fixtures in the round robin stage.

There are 112 entered teams into Diadora Jozi Cup 2024. Eighty-four (84) of these teams are u18 and lower. With all teams playing on one given match date, limited to 30 venues and further limited by the number of facilities suitable to certain divisions, 90 matches will take place.
